

20km Route Description and Power Stations

The JUST WALK 20km route provides a great variety of terrains and scenery and is the perfect way to experience the broad and sweeping landscapes of West Sussex.

We start this walk on the lanes to the east of Goodwood. At 2km we head north with a little ascent to East Dean and to the first of three power stations.

Now still heading north the real challenge starts as we steadily climb along the forestry tracks to the South Downs Way past Waltham Down and Tegleaze. We are now on the South Downs Way and the route is surprisingly flat along the trail, here we find the second of the power stations at Graffham Down with its unique wildlife and ancient Downs woodland.

We then continue walking over the open chalk Downs we start the long drop down through forestry towards Charlton and the final power station.

Once refreshed we continue down the lane to the village of Charlton after which we make a short ascent onto a bridleway and join the edge of the racecourse. Here we have our first glimpse of the finish. With less than 5km to go, the path meets the road and takes us along the final stretch into the grounds of Goodwood: time for a well deserved cheer and lots of congratulations!
